Maintenance Salary-----\$ 1.625 hourly

I. LAW DEPARTMENT

Salary of City Attorney----- 900.00 annually

J. CITY OFFICIALS

Salary of Clerk-Treasurer Assistant----- 15.00 monthly

SECTION 2:

That the salaries of the following officers to be paid from funds of the municipal utilities be as follows:

- A. City Attorney----- 1200.00 annually
- B. Clerk-Treasurer Assistant----- 245.00 monthly
- C. Mayor----- 1500.00 annyally

SECTION 3:

That the annual salaries of the members of the Utility Service Board shall be \$300.00 each.

SECTION 4:

That the salaries of the following employees to be paid from the Parking Meter Fund shall be as follows:

- A. Parking Meter Attendant-----4578.24 annually
- Temporary Patrolman----- 369.20 monthly
- Clerkical Help----- 1.50 per hour

SECTION 5. RECREATION DEPARTMENT

- A. Executive Director-----6500.00 annually
- B. Custodian----- 960.00 annually
- C. Program Director----- 580.00 annually

This ordinance shall take effect January 1, 1966.

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A
CUMULATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT
FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana:

SECTION 1. In accordance with the requirements of Section 8 of Chapter 225, Acts 1965 General Assembly, there is hereby created a special fund to be known as the Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund of Lebanon, Indiana, into which the cigarette Taxes allotted to Lebanon, Indiana, by reason of Subsection C (1) (C) of Section 27C and Section 27d of the Indiana Cigarette Tax Law being Chapter 222 of the Acts of 1947 as amended shall be deposited. Said fund shall be a cumulative fund and all of the monies deposited into said fund shall be appropriated and used solely for capital improvements as hereinafter defined and none of such monies shall revert to the General Fund or be used for any purposes other than capital improvements.

SECTION 2. The term "capital improvements" means the construction or improvement of any property owned by the City of Lebanon, Indiana, including but not limited to streets, thoroughfares and sewers and the retirement of general obligation bonds of Lebanon, Indiana, issued, and the proceeds used for the purpose of constructing capital improvements. The term capital improvement shall not include salaries of any public officials or employees except those which are directly chargeable to the capital improvement.
