OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.

That the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, upon its deliberations have decided that it will adopt the following resolution.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, desires to go on record with reference to the following recommendations.

That any employee shall pay all of his just debts contracted and meet all other obligations undertaken while a member of the Employees of the City of Lebanon. No employee will be permitted to take voluntary bankruptcy without the consent of the Board of Public Works and Safety. No employee shall sign, endorse or agree to secure any note or other obligation to pay money on the part of any other employee without the written consent of the Board of Public Works and Safety.

That any violation of the above conditions shall result in dismissal, without notice, from any employment with the city of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana.

That the word "Employee" is intended to mean as far as this resolution is concerned, all employees of every department of the City of Lebanon, including Police Department, Fire Department, Street Department and any and all other employees of said city.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, adopt the above resolution.
