NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION

To Whom It May Concern:

Notice is hereby given by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that on the 13th day of June, 1966, they unanimously adopted a Declaratory Resolution for the appropriation and purchase of the following described real estate, to-wit:

A part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 19 North, Range 1 East, of the Second Principal Meridian, situated in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is North 0 degrees 23 minutes 50 seconds West 671 feet from the Southeast corner of Southwest quarter of Section 30, Township 19 North, Range 1 East, thence proceed South 89 degrees 59 minutes 44 seconds West 224.47 feet thence North 0 degrees 23 minutes 50 seconds West 60 feet thence North 89 degrees 59 minutes 44 seconds East 224.47 feet, thence South 0 degrees 23 minutes 50 seconds East 60 feet to the point of beginning, containing 0.309 acres, more or less.

A part of the Southeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 19 North, Range 1 East, of the Second Principal Meridian, situated, in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 30, Township 19 North, Range 1 East said point being the intersection of the center-lines of Grant and Fordice Streets, Lebanon, Indiana, proceed thence North 0 degrees 23 minutes 50 seconds West with the quarter section line 731.0 feet, thence South 89 degrees 59 minutes 44 seconds West 60 feet to the place of beginning containing 1.007 acres, more or less.
