ORDINANCE NO. 28

ORDINANCE CREATING A
"LONGEVITY PLAN" COVERING
THE FIRE AND POLICE
DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON, INDIANA, BEGINNING
JANUARY 1, 1967

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

- SECTION 1. That effective January 1, 1967, a "LONGEVITY PLAN" covering the Fire and Police Departments of said City be established;
- SECTION 2. That all Firemen and all Policemen shall serve one (1) year from the time of his first day of service, as a probationary, third (3rd) Class Fireman or Police Officer, third (3rd) class;
- SECTION 3. That all Firemen and Policemen shall serve an additional five (5) years as a First Class Fireman or First Class Policeman;
- SECTION 4. That after completing the fifth (5th) year as a First Class Fireman or a First Class Patrolman, he shall be promoted to the rank of Corporal on the anniversary of acceptance as a First Class Fireman or a First Class Patrolman;
- SECTION 5. That upon attaining his five (5) year status, he shall be given an increase in pay of \$15.00 per month, over and above the existing base pay of a First Class Fireman or First Class Patrolman; further, he shall be entitled to the following increases, to wit; after attainment of ten (10) years' service, \$30.00 per month; fifteen (15) years, \$45.00 per month; twenty (20) years, \$60.00 per month; twenty-five (25) years, \$75.00 per month.
- SECTION 6. That all pensions payable to retired firemen and policemen, retired, shall be based upon the base pay of a First Class Fireman or First Class Policeman and not upon any longevity plan.
