

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by owners of taxable real estate in the City requesting the Common Council to authorize the issuance of bonds of the City for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied on the cost of improvements and expansion of the existing storm water drainage system for Lebanon, Indiana, and for the construction, reconstruction and improvement of city bridges in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, together with the incidental expenses in connection therewith, which petition the Council finds to be in due form, properly verified by signers thereof, and certified by the Auditor of Boone County as being signed by more than fifty owners of taxable real estate in the City of Lebanon; that said petition in all ways conforms to the requirements of the provisions of Section 64-1910, Burns Annotated Statutes, 1961 Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Council now finds that the City has no funds available or provided for in the existing budget and tax levy which may be applied on said projects, making it necessary to authorize the issuance of bonds of the City in order to procure such funds; that an extraordinary emergency exists for the making of the additional appropriation hereinafter set out; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON:

Section 1. That the sum of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand (\$280,000) Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of the proceeds of the bonds designated as "Municipal Bonds of 1966" heretofore authorized to be issued, to be applied on the cost of improvements and expansion of the existing storm water drainage system for Lebanon, Indiana, and for the construction, reconstruction and improvement of city bridges in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, together with the incidental expenses in connection therewith, requested by the Board of Public Works and Safety, and the incidental expenses necessary to be incurred in connection with such projects and the issuance of bonds on account thereof.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

NOTICE OF PETITION FOR AND  
DETERMINATION TO ISSUE BONDS

Taxpayers of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, are hereby notified that a petition has been filed by more than fifty owners of taxable real estate located in said City requesting the Common Council to authorize the issuance of bonds of the City in an amount not exceeding the sum of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand (\$280,000) Dollars, for the purpose of procuring funds to be applied for the cost of improvements and expansion of the existing storm water drainage system for Lebanon, Indiana, and for the construction, reconstruction, and improvement of city bridges in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, together with the incidental expenses in connection therewith. Remonstrances against the issuance of said bonds may be filed with the Common Council in the manner and within the time provided by Section 64-1910, Burns Annotated Statutes, 1961 replacement.

Taxpayers of the City of Lebanon are further notified that the Common Council did, on the 11th day of July, 1966, adopt Ordinance No. 29, thereby determining to issue the bonds of the City in the amount of \$280,000, maturing serially over a period of
