

election of 1967, payable from the General Fund of said City, shall be in the following amounts:

SECTION 2. The Clerk-Treasurer is ordered and directed to publish this ordinance twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the English language in this City, the first of which publications shall be at least 30 days prior to the date of the passage of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force from and after its passage, and shall be effective as to the salaries provided herein on and after January 1, 1968.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ALIENATION
AND CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED
BY THE CITY OF LEBANON, BOONE COUNTY, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the common council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, to sell the following described real estate, to-wit:

Part of the Southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, described as follows:

Commencing at the Northeast corner of said tract, running thence South along the East line thereof 145 feet to the point of beginning; continuing thence South along the aforesaid East line a distance of 1434.7 feet to a point; deflecting thence to the right an angle of 90 degrees 29 minutes 48 seconds and proceeding a distance of 571.0 feet to a point; deflecting thence to the right an angle of 90 degrees 21 minutes 53 seconds and proceeding a distance of 1418.5 feet to a point; deflecting thence to the right an angle of 87 degrees 56 minutes 54 seconds and proceeding a distance of 549.8 feet to the point of beginning, containing 18.35 Acres, more or less, but subject to all legal highways and rights-of way.

Located in Washington Township, Boone County, Indiana.

Section 2. That said sale shall be for cash and for not less than the value thereof to be determined by three disinterested freeholders of said City to be appointed by the Judge of the Boone Circuit Court, pursuant to Statute.

Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby empowered to execute a proper Deed for said sale attested by the Clerk-Treasurer of said City.
