

Councilman Wild thereupon introduced an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, appropriating the sum of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand (\$280,000) Dollars to be applied for the cost of improvements and expansion of the existing storm water drainage system for Lebanon, Indiana, and for the construction, reconstruction and improvement of city bridges in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, together with the incidental expenses in connection therewith and on account of the issuance of bonds therefor," and moved that said Ordinance be numbered and placed on first reading, and that the same be read by title and in full at this time.

Said motion was seconded by Councilman Campbell, and on call of the roll was carried by the following vote:

Ayes: Hopkins, Daily, Tribbett, Campbell and Wild.
Nays: None.

Said Ordinance, having been designated as Ordinance No. 30, and having been read by title and in full, Councilman Hopkins moved that said Ordinance be carried over for further consideration until a meeting of the Council to be held on August 22, 1966; that a public hearing be held on said Ordinance at said meeting, and that the Clerk-Treasurer be instructed to publish a notice to the taxpayers of such hearing, once each week for two weeks in The Lebanon Reporter and The Jamestown Press, and to post said notice in three public places in the City at least ten days prior to said date. This motion was seconded by Councilman Daily, and on call of the roll was adopted by the following vote:

Ayes: Hopkins, Daily, Tribbett, Campbell and Wild.
Nays: None.

The presiding officer then declared said motion carried and instructed the Clerk-Treasurer to publish and post notice of such public hearing as provided in the foregoing motion.

There being no further business presented, on motion duly made, seconded and unanimously carried, the meeting was thereupon adjourned.
