AN ORDINANCE

Entitled: An ordinance granting to LEBANON CATV, INC., its successors and assigns, the right privilege and permit to construct and operate a community antenna and closed-circuit electronic system within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Indiana, and its environs, and use and occupy the streets, alleys, and other public places of said city for such purpose.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

SECTION 1. There is hereby granted to LEBANON CATV, INC., its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and permit to construct and operate a community antenna and closed-circuit electronic system within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Indiana, and its environs, hereinafter called "City", to furnish and sell the service from such system to the inhabitants of the city and its environs, and to use and occupy the streets, alleys and other public places within the city for the placement of wires, cables, poles and other supporting structures necessary to said system.

SECTION 2. So far as practical, the grantee shall use existing poles such as those erected and maintained by the Indiana Bell Telephone Company and the Lebanon Utilities where satisfactory rental agreement can be reached with the Telephone Company and the electric system. New poles will be placed only at locations where existing poles are inadequate or not available.

SECTION 3 Any streets or sidewalks disturbed or damaged in the construction or maintenance of said system shall be promptly repaired to the satisfaction of the city by and
