

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO LEBANON CATV, INC., ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS QUALIFIED TO DO BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF INDIANA THE RIGHT TO ERECT, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE IN, UNDER, OVER, ALONG, ACROSS, AND UPON THE STREETS, LANES, AVENUES, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS BRIDGES, AND HIGHWAYS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, AND SUBSEQUENT ADDITIONS THERETO, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION BY CABLE OF TELEVISION SIGNALS TO ENABLE SALE OF THEIR COMMUNITY TELEVISION ANTENNA SERVICE TO THE INHABITANTS OF SAID CITY AND OTHER PURPOSES FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY (20) YEARS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

#### SECTION 1

##### GRANT OF AUTHORITY

In consideration of the faithful performance and the provisions of this franchise and grant hereinafter specified, the right is hereby granted to LEBANON CATV, INC. its successors, assigns, or designees hereinafter designated as the COMPANY, the franchise and non-exclusive right to erect, maintain and operate closed circuit television transmission and distribution facilities and additions thereto in, under, over along, across, and upon the streets, lawns, avenues, sidewalks, alleys, bridges and other public places within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Indiana, and subsequent additions thereto, for the purpose of transmission and distribution of television and FM radio impulses and signals and television energy in accordance with the laws and regulations of the United States of America and the State of Indiana and the ordinances and regulations of the City of Lebanon, Indiana for a period of twenty (20) years.

#### SECTION II

So far as practical, the grantee shall use existing poles such as those erected and maintained by the Indiana Bell Telephone Company and the Lebanon Utilities where satisfactory rental agreement can be reached with the Telephone Company and the Electric system. New poles will be placed only at locations where existing poles are inadequate or not available.

#### SECTION III

Any streets or sidewalks disturbed or damaged in the construction or maintenance of said system shall be promptly repaired to the satisfaction of the city by and at the expense of the grantee.

#### SECTION IV

All wires, cables, poles and other supporting structures necessary to said system erected within the corporate limits of Lebanon, Indiana, by the grantee shall at all times meet with the minimum standards of the City, as provided by code or ordinance.
