ORDINANCE NO. 68-1

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES OR OTHER VEHICLES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF EXPLANADE STREET BETWEEN LEBANON STREET AND WEST STREET AND PROHIBITING SAID VEHICLES FROM PARKING FOR A DISTANCE OF SEVENTY-FIVE (75) FEET ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF ESPLANADE STREET FROM SAID LEBANON STREET INTERSECTION, PROVIDING PENALTIES AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, INCLUDING ORDINANCE NO. 26 PASSED ON THE 7TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1966.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

Section I: It shall be unlawful to park or leave standing any automobile motor truck, bus or any other vehicle on the north side of Explanade Street in said City, between North Lebanon Street and North West Street in said City at any time.

Section II: It shall be unlawful to park or leave standing any automobile, motor truck, bus or any other vehicle on the south side of Esplanade Street in said City, for a distance of seventy-five (75) feet, measured in a straight line from the projection of the west curb line across the North Lebanon Street intersection in said city at any time.

Section III. Any person violating the provisions of Sections I and II hereof shall, upon conviction, be fined in any sum of not less than One Dollar (1.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Section IV: All Ordinances in conflict with the above are hereby repealed, including Ordinance No. 26 passed by the Common Council on the 7th day of February, 1966, entitled: AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES OR OTHER VEHICLES ON EITHER SIDE OF ESPLANADE STREET BETWEEN LEBANON STREET AND WEST STREET.
