OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
OF LEBANON, INDIANA

RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING ON PATTERSON STREET FROM RAILROAD TO CREEK

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-third of it's members being present and concurring therein, that

1. Stewart Warner has ample parking space for their employees, and
2. Patterson Street is very congested during certain hours of the day, and
3. The motion was made by the Councilman Holloman to make the west side of Patterson Street from the railroad north to the Creek a no-parking area and this was seconded by Councilman Shoemaker and on voice vote, Councilmen Smith, Stump, Shoemaker, Scott and Holloman voted aye.
