AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION
ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE DEPARTMENTS NAMED
FOR THE YEAR 1968, AS
RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY
CLERK-TREASURER OF THE
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now of a necessity to appropriate more money than was appropriated to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that for the expense of City Government of the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the General Fund for the purpose herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2: That for said fiscal period there is hereby to be appropriated out of the General and Motor Vehicle Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

NOTICE OF OFFICIAL ACTION

OF

INDIANA STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, under and by virtue of the Statutes of the State of Indiana relative to traffic regulation, the Indiana State Highway Commission has the authority and the duty to adopt and promulgate regulations in the interest of the safety and convenience of the traveling public using the highways including streets in cities and towns, under the control of said Commission, be it known that the following traffic regulation is hereby adopted:

A flashing beacon shall be installed at the intersection of SR 39 and Maple Drive in the City of Lebanon, Boone County, flashing yellow for SR 39 and red for Maple Drive.
