ORDINANCE NO. 1-69

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS WITHIN ABNER LONGLEY PARK AND LEBANON MEMORIAL PARK IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, IDNIANA AND PROVIDING PENALATIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Section 1 That is shall be unlawful for any representation, Indiana.

Section 1 That is shall be unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle on a public road within Abner Longley Park and Lebanon Memorial Park in the City of Lebanon, Indiana at a speed in excess of fifteen miles per hour (14mph).

Section 2. This shall in no way abridge or impair the right of the Board of Park Commissioners of the City of Lebanon to designate what roads within said parks shall be open to thepublic, and also to close the roads entirely to public traffic during the winter months, or any other times that said Board may decide is in the public interest. Section Said City shall erect appropriate signs warning drivers of vehicles of this ordinance.

Section 4 Any person who sahll violate the provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction therof be fined in any sum not less than one Dollar(\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).

Section 5 Whereas an emergency exists this ordinance shall be infull force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approved by the Mayor.

Passed in Open Council this 14th day of April, 1969 after suspension of the rules duly authorized by said Council.
