PETITION TO DEDICATE ALLEY

Comes now the Petitioner herein, the Boone County Farm Bureau, INC. and for its Petition to Dedicate Alley, alleges and says:

1. That it is the owner, in fee simple, of the following described real estate and that said description set out below has been surveyed by a Registered Surveyor:

A part of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 1 East, and being more particularly described as follows:

From the northeast corner of said tract run first west 191.0 feet to the center of a proposed 20 foot alley, thence deflect 93 degrees 43 minutes to the left and proceed on said deflection 210 feet to the end of said proposed alley.

The west line of said alley measures 217.8 feet and the east line measures 202.2 feet.

2. That it is its intention herein to dedicate and it does by this Petition dedicate said real estate hereinabove described as an alley to the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the Board of Public Works or the City Council, whichever having jurisdiction, resolve to accept said real estate as an alley dedicated by Petitioner herein to the City of Lebanon, Indiana.
