

Be it further declared by action of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that the annexation, dedication and acknowledgement of said real estate with uses, purposes, et cetera, pertaining thereto as tendered by the Trustees of the Church of Christ is hereby declared as accepted; and now said real estate and the dedication thereof for the uses and purposes set fourth in the Petition and Annexation and Dedication is hereby accepted and the same is hereby declared be a part of the incorporated City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, but subject to the following conditions;

A. That the petitioner, Church of Christ, by and through its Trustee, will use electricity, water and sewage facilities as provided by the Lebanon Utilities of Lebanon, Indiana.

B. That all real estate herein annexed is hereby declared annexed for the specific use of a Church and for the specific construction and erection of a Church, Church building and possibly a Church or Minister's parsonage.

C. That the building setback lines for the above tract on the east and immediately west of Business Route 52 shall be not less than 60 feet; that the interior building set back lines on both the north and south boundary of said tract shall be not less than 25 feet.

The aforesaid motion was seconded by Councilman Stump.

The motion aforesaid as moved and seconded was passed by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, at the first reading this 13 day of October, 1969, and ordered published according to law.
