ORDINANCE NO. 9-69

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE BURNING OF RUBBISH INCLUDING LEAVES DURING THE DARK HOURS OF THE DAY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana,

SECTION 1. It is the express intention of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, to protect the public from the burning of rubbish within said city in two (2) respects to wit:

1. The burning of rubbish during the night time, or in the dark hours of the day, as herein after defined, constitutes a safety hazard to vehicular traffic traveling on the streets of the said city.

2. That the burning of trash, as hereinafter regulated may constitute a factor injurious to public health within said city limits by reason of polluting the air.

SECTION 2. Bonfires and Outdoor Rubbish Fires.

1. Location Restricted. No persons shall kindle or maintain any bonfire or
