

ORDINANCE NO. 4-69

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2, 1956, THESAME BEING AS ORDINANCE REGULATING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF PLUMBING HEATING AND VENTILATING AND ELECTRIC WIRING AND PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PLUMBERS HEATING TRADESMEN AND ELECTRICIANS THE ISSURANCE OF PERMITS AND PENALATIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING TWO ORDINANCE ONE PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, MAY 11 1936 AND THE OTHER PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 13TH DAY OF APRIL 1953.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, TWO-THIRDS OF ITS MEMBERS BEING PRESENT AND CONCURRING THERIN THAT:

SECTION k. SECTION 6 of said Ordinance be amended to read as follows to wit:

"SECTION 6 It is further previded that a qualified non-resident contractor who is the successful bidder on a construction contract in said city can establish his ability to perform the business of plumbing, heating and ventilating or electrical wiring by complying with the heretofore set out provisions of this ordinance, can obtain a temorary permit to do business at any designated address within the city limits of Lebanon, Indiana during the course of said construction said business to be confined to the site of said construction Provided said temporary permit shall not be issued for a period of more than sixty (60) days. The fee for said permit shall be \$10.00 payable to the City Clerk at the time of issurance of said permit. If no complaints have been received against work performed by the holder of a temporary permit issued hereunder, The City Clerk is authorized to renew said temporary permit for sonsecutive sixty(60) day periods upon payment of a like fee of \$10.00 for each renewal.

SECTION. 2 This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

Ordinance No. 2, 1956

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BUSINESS OF PLUMBING, HEATING AND VENTILATING AND ELECTRICAL WIRING, AND PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF PLUMBERS HEATING TRADESMEN AND ELECTRICIANS THE ISSURANCE OF PERMITS AND PENALATIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING TWO ORDINANCES, ONE PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL, MAY 11, 1936 AND THE OTHER PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL ON THE 13TH DAY OF APRIL, 1953.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, TWO-THIRDS OF ITS MEMBERS BEING PRESENT AND CONCURRING THEREIN THAT:

SECTION 1. Any person, firm, or corporation desiring to activety engage in the business of plumbing heating and ventilating or electrical wiring in the City of Lebanon, Indiana shall file in the office of the City Clerk of said City an application giving the name and place of business of the individual firm or corporation of which said applicant is a member. Said application shall state that the applicant is a master of him trade and that he is willing to be goverened in all respects by all rules and regulations that have hereafter be adopted by said Common Council pertaining to the above set out business. Each applicant shall further at the time of filing his application agree to appear before an examining board per-taing to his respective business, composed as herinafter set out, for examination as to his qualifications and expirence in said business provided, that in the event the applicant is a
