

firm or corporation, some member of said firm, or officer of said corporation shall appear before the Board. After said examination, which may be written or oral, said applicant shall be notified with five days of the results of his examination and the examination board shall forward the results of said examination to the Common Council with the recommendation of the board as to whether the license shall be granted or denied. Upon receiving the results of the examination, the applicant shall, if the recommendation of the Examining Board is to grant the license, deposit with the City Clerk a bond with two or more residents of said city as sureties thereon and a reputable Surety Company to be approved by the Common Council at the time of the granting of said license as recommended by said Examining Board, in the sum of One Thousand (1,000.00) Dollars, conditioned that he will indemnify and save harmless said city from all liability and damage caused by his negligence or carelessness in the performance of his work at the trade in which he is licensed; and conditioned further that he will pay all fines that may be imposed upon him for violation of this Ordinance or any of said rules or regulations. Said applicant shall also exhibit a certificate of a policy of liability insurance to indemnify third parties for any damages they might suffer as a result of his work. Upon approval of said bond and insurance policy and the granting of said license by said Council, the Clerk shall issue to such applicant a license authorizing such applicant to operate and do business in said City in accordance with his license and for which said applicant shall pay said Clerk a fee of \$25.00 provided that said license may be renewed each consecutive year hereafter by the said applicant upon the payment of a fee of \$5.00 and upon satisfactory compliance with the other provisions of this Ordinance, provided further that, if no complaints have been received against said applicant's work as hereinafter set out in Section 6 hereof, said applicant for a renewal license shall not be required to appear before said Examination Board. No License shall be granted for a period of longer than one year and all licenses will expire on the 31st day of December of the current year in which they are issued unless sooner revoked for cause as hereinafter set out.

SECTION 2. All work done by or under the supervision of any person, firm or corporation licensed for the business of electrical wiring hereunder shall conform to the MINIMUM STANDARDS OF THE NATIONAL BOARD OF FIRE UNDERWRITERS FOR ELECTRICAL WIRING AND APPARATUS. Said standards are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance. All work done by or under the supervision of any person firm or corporation licensed for the business of plumbing or heating and ventilating shall conform to the MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE BUILDING CODE. Said requirements are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance. Failure to conform to the above minimums shall be cause for the revocation of the license issued hereunder. B C

SECTION 3. There shall be set up a Board of Examination for each of the above set out businesses. Each Board of Examination shall determine the fitness of the applicants for license by either an oral or written examination. Said Board shall be composed of the Five (5) members as follows:

(a) The Board of Examination for the Electrical Wiring Business shall consist of one Councilman, the City Building Inspector, and three (3) public members who are familiar with the electrical wiring business, no more than two (2) of whom shall be actively engaged in the business at the time of their appointment.
