

(b) The Board of Examination for the Plumbing Business shall consist of one (1) Councilman, the City Building Inspector and Three (3) Public members who are familiar with the plumbing business, no more than two (2) of whom shall be actively engaged in the business at the time of their appointment

(c) The Board of Examination for the Heating and Ventilating Business shall consist of one (1) Councilman, the City Building Inspector and three (3) public members who are familiar with the heating and ventilating business no more than two (2) of whom shall be actively engaged in the business at the time of their appointment.

The member from the council on the above boards shall be appointed by the Mayor to serve during said Councilman's term of office and the public shall be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the council. The appointment of the public members shall be for a period of one (1) year. Provided, that the public members actively engaged in said businesses shall not serve more than one (1) year consecutively.

SECTION 4: Plumbing as used in this ordinance shall be construed to include steam and hot water heating. Heating and Ventilating shall be construed to include warm air heating and duct ventilating.

SECTION 5: The Boards of Examination above set out shall meet after their appointment and elect from their membership a Chairman, Vice Chairman, and Secretary. It shall be the duty of the Chairman to preside at all meetings, provided that the Vice-Chairman shall preside in the Chairman's absence. The Secretary of each board shall keep minutes of all meetings and forward the results of all examination to the Council along with the recommendation of the Board. It will be necessary for a majority of the members to be present at any meeting. No member of the Council who is actively engaged in any of the above set out businesses shall be appointed a member of the Board of Examination pertaining to his business. Each Board shall meet to pass upon all applicants in their respective business upon notification to the Chairman or Vice-Chairman of pending application by the City Clerk; said meeting to be called by the Chairman and in his absence by the Vice-Chairman.

SECTION 6: It is further provided that a qualified non-resident contractor who is the successful bidder on a construction contract in said City and can establish his ability to perform the business of plumbing, heating, and ventilating or electrical wiring by complying with the heretofore set out provisions of this ordinance, can obtain a temporary permit to do business at any designated address within the city limits of Lebanon, Indiana during the course of said construction said business to be confined to the site of said construction. Provided said temporary permit shall not be issued for a period of more than sixty-(60) days. The fee for said permit shall be \$10.00 payable to the City Clerk at the time of the issuance of said permit. If no complaints have been received against work performed by the holder of a temporary permit issued hereunder, the City Clerk is authorized to renew said temporary permit for consecutive sixty (60) day period upon payment of a like of \$5.00 for each renewal.

Said temporary permit shall not be renewed after the holder thereof completed his contract as above set out.

SECTION 7: The Common Council shall have the power to revoke the license herein granted upon complaint by the building inspector and proof that said applicant has failed to meet the minimum requirements as above set out.
