

rubbish fire or authorize any such fire to be kindled or maintained on any private land unless (1) the location is not less than fifty (50) feet from any structure and adequate provisions is made to prevent fire from spreading to within (50) feet of any structure, or (2) the fire is contained in an approved waste burner located safely not less than fifteen (15) feet from any sturcture.

2. Chief May Prohibit. The Chief of the Fire Department may prohibit any or all bonfires and outdoor rubbish fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fire hazardous.

SECTION 3. No persons shall burn any leaves, rubbish or weeds in the City of Lebanon during the dark hous of the day or night time, except that the Mayor may issue a procolamation designating a clean-up week and other times and fix houss during the days of such weeks and other times that it shall be lawful to burn leaves, rubbish or weeds.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of this ordinance, the nighttime houss shall be defined from one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hour after sunset to one-half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hour before sunrise.

SECTION 5. The Chief of the Fire Department of said city shall have the right to inspect places for the burhing of such trash and may designate the type of containers in which said rubbish may be burned, as well as the location of the same, in order to prevent a possible fire hazard.

SECTION 6. Any person villating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fines of not less then One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) and it is hereby declared that the viblation of this ordinance on succeeding days shall be a seperate offense for each day.

SECTION 7. For the purpose of this ordinance, garbage shall be defined as kitchen waste and other waste matter and vegetable matter. It is hereby declared that no garbage within the meaning of the definition of this section shall be burned at any time within said city.

SECTION 8. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances heretofore passed, which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, but this ordinance is not intended to repeal any provisions of an ordinance passed on the 26th day of November, 1962, adopting a Fire Prevention Code.
