

4. Restricted areas. No person shall enter any area designated by the Mayor as a restricted area unless in the performance of official duties or with permission from the Mayor or his duly designated representative or such person shall prove residence therein.

SECTION 6. Penalty.

Any person violating any provision of this ordinance or any order made by the Mayor of the City in accordance with the terms of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and/or imprisonment in the county jail for a period not to exceed six (6) months. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage as by law provided.
