ORDINANCE NO. 3-70

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana,

SECTION 1 That Section 2 of an Ordinance regarding the use of meters and fixing rates for the use of water by meter passed by the Common Council on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1957, as Ordinance No. 47 be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2 There shall be and there are hereby established for the use of and the services rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Lebanon, the following rates charges, based upon the amount of water supplied during each monthly billing period:

CONSUMPTION		RATE PER 100 Cubic Feet
First	500 cubic feet	\$ 0.70
Next	1000 cubic feet	.62
Next	2000 cubic feet	.53
Next	4000 cubic feet	.45
Next	8000 cubic feet	.36
over	15500 cubic feet	.28

Each user shall pay a minimum monthly charge in accordance with the size of meter installed for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out in the above schedule of rates.

PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION

The amount to be paid by the City of Lebanon for fire hydrant rental shall be \$ 84.00 per hydrant per year, payable semi-annually.

PRIVATE FIRE PROTECTION

Hydrant Rental-each per annum \$ 84.00

COLLECTION OF DEFERRED PAYMENT CHARGE

All bills for water service not paid within 10 days from the due date thereof shall as stated in such bills, shall be subject to a collection of deferred payment charge of 10% on the first \$ 3.00 and 3% on the excess over \$3.00.

TEMPORARY USERS

Water furnished to temporary users, such as contractors, circuses, etc. shall be charges on the basis of the above quantity rates as estimated by the Waterworks Superintendent.

RAILROADS

Water supplies for railroad use may be charges for on such terms as shall be fixed by specific contract approved by the Common Council and the Public Service Commissioners of Indiana.
