

of approximately 460 volts or lower.

Service hereunder may be metered at a primary voltage, which is designated as a standard voltage of approximately 2,300 volts or higher in which event before computing the charges, the actual measurement of energy shall be decreased by five per cent (5%) to convert to the equivalent of service metered at a secondary voltage.

MINIMUM BILL

The total monthly minimum bill shall be \$1.00 per horse-power or fraction thereof for the first 10-Horse-power of the connected power load and \$0.50 per horse-power or fraction thereof for all connected power load in excess of 10 horse-power.

Any customer having a connected power load of 75 horse-power, or more, may request Company to install a suitable indicating or recording instrument for obtaining maximum load measurement, and such maximum load measurement shall be used as the basis for computing the Monthly Minimum Bill instead of the connected power load. In the event of such request, the maximum load of such Customer in any month thereafter shall be deemed the average number of kilowatts in the thirty minute interval in such month, and the measurement so determined shall be multiplied by 1.34 in order to convert to equivalent horse¹/power. In the event of such request, the Monthly Minimum Bill of such Customer for any month thereafter shall be based on the highest equivalent horse-power in the period of twelve consecutive months ending with the expiration of the current billing month (or in such portion of such period as shall have elapsed subsequent to the effective date of such request), at the rate of \$1.00 per horse-power or fraction thereof for the first 10 horse-power so determined and \$.0.50 per horse-power or fraction thereof for all horse-power in excess of 10 horse-power so determined, but in no event shall such Monthly Minimum Bill be less than \$ 25.00.

SECTION 2 That the following Schedule for Electric Primary Power and Light Service is hereby adopted and approved and is in the best interests of the public served by the City of Lebanon Indiana.

Availability

Available for any Customer having a Billing Maximum Load of 25 Kilowatts, or more, except as hereinafter provided, Applicant must be located adjacent to an electric transmission or distribution line of Company this is adjacent and suitable for supplying the service requested in Lebanon, Indiana.

CHARTER OF SERVICE

Alternating current having a frequency of sixty cycles and furnished in accordance with the provisions set forth hereunder.

Rate

Maximum Load Charge (Monthly)

\$ 1.50 per month per kilowatt of Billing Maximum Load in the month.

ENERGY CHARGE (In addition to the Maximum Load Charge)

2.0¢ per KWH for the first 3,000 KWH used in any month

1.8 per KWH for the next 7,000 KWH used in any month

1.2 1.2 per KWH for the next 10,000 KWH used in any month

1.0 per KWH for the Next 80,000 KWH used in any month

0.8 per KW¹ for the next 100,000 KWH used in any month

0.7 per KWH for the next 200,000 KWH used in any month

Measurement of Maximum Load Energy

Maximum load shall be measured by suitable indicating or recording instruments and in any month the maximum load shall be the average number of kilowatts in the thirty-minute interval during which the energy metered is greater than in any other thirty-minute interval in such month. When energy is metered more than one meter (permitted, in the case of secondary metering, under paragraph 1 of Terms and Conditions for Rendering Service) the maximum loads, separately determined for each meter, shall be added together for determining the maximum load for the month. Energy shall be measured by suitable integrating instruments.
