PENAL ORDINANCE NO. 6-70

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN CERTAIN AREAS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON INDIANA, ESTABLISHING PENALTIES AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH, PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana,

Section 1 It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle for ;more than two (2) hours continuously in any metered parking area surrounding the Courthouse Square in the City of Lebanon, Indiana during the hours that parking is metered on said streets. The area surroudding the Courthouse Square in the City of Lebanon, Indiana is hereby declared to be a congested parking area and for that reason said parking time shall not be extended.

Section 2. On any other metered parking area in any of the streets or parking lots in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, additional time in park in said can be obtained by adding additional, appropriate coins to the appropriate parking meter.

Section 3 The fact that motor vehicle is owned by a person and the fact that a motor vehicle is in a parking space shall be prima facie evidence that a motor vehicle is parking in the parking space by the owner.
