PROVIDING FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS
FOR THE DEPARTMENTS NAMED FOR THE YEAR

TREASURER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, IND.

WHEREAS, Certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget so that it is now of a necessity to appropriate more money than was appropriated to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, IND. that for the expense of City Government of the following sums of money are hereby appropriated and set apart out of the General Fund for the purpose herein specified subject to the laws governing the same, such sums herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures authorized to be made during the year, unless otherwise expressly stipulated and provided by law.

SECTION 2. That for said fiscal period there is hereby to be appropriated out of the General Fund, the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are hereby declared to exist:

Taxpayers appearing at such meeting shall have a right to be heard thereon. The Additional Appropriations as finally made will be automatically referred to the State Board of Tax Commissioners will hold a further hearing within fifteen days at the County Auditors' Office of Boone County, Indiana or at such other place as may be designated. At such hearing taxpayers objecting any of such additional appropriations may be heard and interested taxpayers may inquire of the County Auditor when and where such hearing is to be heard.

Presented to the Common Council and read in full this 27th day of July, 1970. To be presented at next Council meeting on August 10, 1970 for final reading which will constitute a public hearing for all taxpayers.
