PENAL ORDINANCE No. 13-70

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CERTAIN PARKING IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCE IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful to park between 7:00 AM and 4:00 PM on North Meridian Street in said city between North and the extension of what would be Williams Street, except on Saturdays Sundays and holidays.

SECTION 2 Penalties Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in any sum, not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) in addition to which said vehicle violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to be towed away at the owners expense.

SECTION 3 All ordinances or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 This ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication thereof, according to law.

PENAL ORDINANCE NO. 15-70

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING PARKING OF TRUCKS IN THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana,

Section 1. No Parking - Trucks and Certain Other Vehicles.

(a) No person shall park a truck at any time on any of the streets in said City. A truck, as the term is used in this section, is a vehicle with an overall length of twenty feet (20') or more, or over one (1) ton capacity, and includes semi-trailer trucks and either the tractor pulling the same, or the trailer itself.

(b) This section does not prohibit the parking of trucks on said streets for the purpose of loading or unloading goods, or merchandise, for any store or business establishment located on any such street.

(c) No person shall stop, stand or park a truck on any street other than for the expeditious loading or unloading of freight for more than one (1) hour, except in cases of emergency when said truck is broken down and unable to move, and except also in the event a moving van is loading or unloading the furniture and household goods, or the furniture and equipment and goods, wares and merchandise of a business in either of which events the operator of said truck will have a reasonable time in which to move his said truck.

(d) No person shall park a house trailer or motorized house cruiser on any of the streets in said city with an overall length of twenty feet (20') or more.

Section 2. Penalties, Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in any sum, not exceeding Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), in addition to which said vehicle violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to be towed away
