

Resolution 1-71

Be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that the two (2) parking spaces immediately to the south of the office of the Indiana Bell Telephone Company in Lebanon, Indiana, nearest to the intersection of Washington Street with North West Street in said city, be set aside for parking by the patrons of said telephone company.

Be it further resolved that the parking time for each of said parking spaces shall be ten (10) minutes, which shall be effective from 8:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M. except Saturday and Sunday, Holidays and that the said telephone company shall furnish the appropriate signs at its expense, for installation at said parking spaces, and that said telephone company shall provide for the maintenance of said signs so installed.

Be it further resolved that the length of each space will be determined by the City Street Superintendent.

The undersigned, Laura E. Hughes, Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, hereby certifies that at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, held in the Council Chambers in the Municipal Building in said City of Lebanon, Indiana, on the 27th day of October, 1971, the following proceedings were had:

With the Honorable Robert M. Campbell, Mayor, presiding, the roll call showed all members of the Common Council present and voting.

Councilman Shoemaker made the following motion to adopt an Ordinance which reads as follows, to wit:

1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, that the real estate as is hereinafter described, to wit:

TRACT I. A part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 18 North, Range 1 East of the Second Principal Meridian, located in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana, and being more particularly described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Northeast Quarter, thence North 0 Degrees 20 Minutes 53 Seconds East along the West line of the Northeast Quarter a distance of 1431.392 feet, thence North 89 Degrees 58 Minutes 54 Seconds East a distance of 200.00 feet, thence North 0 Degrees 20 Minutes 53 Seconds East a distance of 271.35 feet, thence North 89 Degrees 58 Minutes 54 Seconds East
