

2. That the real estate herein annexed is hereby annexed for the specific use of apartment houses pursuant to Chart 4 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, as to Tract I, and for the specific use of a general business use pursuant to Chart 7 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, as to Tract II.

3. All plans for the construction of any buildings shall be approved by the City Plan Commission of Lebanon, Indiana, before any construction and/or development begins.

4. No public or private trailer camp, nor any house trailer or mobile home for human habitation shall be permitted on either or both tracts herein described.

5. Any or all streets to be accepted for maintenance by the City of Lebanon, Indiana, for general public use are to be constructed according to specifications of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, Street Department.

ORDINANCE 72-8

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 4-1970 and establishing emergency temporary rates and charges for service rendered by the Municipal Electric Utility of the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has received a Resolution of the Utility Service Board representing the need to increase rates and charges of the Municipal Electric Utility to provide additional revenues equal to the amount of increase in cost of wholesale electricity purchased from Public Service Indiana and the increase in gross income tax in order to continue the operation of the Municipal Electric Utility in a sound financial basis:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

Section 1. That the rates and charges for service rendered by the Municipal Electric Utility of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, be, and the same are, hereby ordered, as follows:
