ORDINANCE 72-12

Entitled: An Ordinance annexing certain contiguous territory into the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and acknowledgment of the use thereof

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Councilmen of the City of Lebanon, Indiana:

Section 1. The territory described in this Section 1 is hereby annexed into the City of Lebanon, Indiana, upon the terms and conditions contained herein, said property being located in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Section 2. That the portion of said real estate above described located to the east of Interstate Highway 65 be set aside for light industrial uses as described in Chart 8 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and that property situated to the west of Interstate Highway 65 be set aside for general business uses as provided in Chart 7 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Lebanon.

Section 3. That the Petitioner Karro, Inc., its successors or assigns agrees to construct and extend the water main and the sanitary sewer system from its present location to the annexed property at its expense, all such construction to be performed in a workmanlike manner and according to the Ten-State Code as well as successors in interest or assigns should dedicate the same to the City of Lebanon, the City does hereby agree to maintain the same and reserves the right to inspect all construction of said construction of said facilities.

Section 4. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby amended accordingly.

Section 5. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any of the sections, provisions, exceptions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or parts be held unconstitutional or void, the remainder of this Ordinance shall continue in full force and effect, it being the intent now hereby declared that this Ordinance would have been adopted even if such unconstitutional or void matter had not been included therein.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall become effective September 25, 1972.
