WHEREAS: Herbert L. Ransdall had been an outstanding citizen of Lebanon, Indiana for many years, and

WHEREAS: As a public servant of unusual talent, he served in many responsible positions of leadership in said City for many yeats, participating in numerous activities of the community including active and faithful service to his church and the American Legion, and
