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RESOLUTION 73-2

RESOLUTION APPROVING PARTICIPATION BY LOCAL HOUSING OWNERS IN THE FEDERAL RENT SUPPLEMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS: under the provisions of Section 101 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1965, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, acting by and through the Federal Housing Commission (herein called the "Commissioner") is authorized to enter into contracts to make rent supplement payments to certain qualified housing owners on behalf of qualified low-income persons or families; and

WHEREAS: such persons or families shall be deemed eligible to participate in the benefits of the rent supplement program (1) if their income limits are within those of public housing locally or within the income limits for rent supplement housing as determined by the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and (2) if they qualify in one of the following ways: are elderly (62 years of age or older) or physically handicapped (or have an elderly or physically handicapped husband or wife), are displaced by governmental action, are occupants of substandard housing, are present or former occupants of dwellings damaged or destroyed by a natural disaster since April 1, 1965; and (3) if their total assets do not exceed \$2,000, unless the applicant is 62 years of age or older, in which case assets may total \$5,000 (personal property excluded); and (4) if the Commissioner has issued a certificate of eligibility on behalf of the applicant; and

WHEREAS: the provisions of said Section 101 cannot be made available to housing owners in certain localities unless the governing body of the locality has by resolution given approval for such participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program.

NOW THEREFORE: be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana as follows:

Approval is hereby granted for participation in the Federal Rent Supplement Program by qualified housing owners of property located in the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana.
