## RESOLUTION 73-3

WHEREAS, certain acts of the State of Indiana and the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 provide financial aid for the construction of sewage treatment works; and

WHEREAS, Lebanon, Indiana, herein called the Municipality, has plans for a municipal water pollution control project generally described as advaced waste treatment facility, which plans will be prepared and the Municipality intends to proceed with the contruction of such works;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, the governing body of said Municipality, as follows:

1. That Thomas J. Burrin, Utilities Manager of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, be authorized to make application for a State grant and provide the Stream Pollution Control Board such information, data, and documents pertaining to the application for a grant as may be required, and otherwise act as the authorized representative of the Municipality in connection with said application.
2. That the Municipality agrees that if a Federal grant and State assistance for the Project are provided pursuant to Title 2, Section 201g of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act of 1972 as amended and Acts of the State of Indiana, the Municipality will pay the remaining cost of the approved construction.
3. That all statements, data, and supporting documents made or submitted by the Municipality in connection with any application for Federal assistance for the proposed consrtuction are to be deemed a part of the application for State assistance.
4. That the Municipality agrees to comply with the requirements of the Stream Pollution Control Board.
5. That certified copies of this resolution be prepared in quadruplicate to accomany an application for a State grant for the construction of the municipal water pollution control project.
