

ORDINANCE NO. 73-18

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION II OF AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION I OF AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF TABLES, ALLEYS, GALLERYS OR OTHER DEVICES PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, ON THE 11TH DAY OF APRIL, 1932" SAID AMENDING ORDINANCE HAVING BEEN PASSED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL MAY 29, 1933.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

SECTION I: That Section II of the Ordinance Amending Section I of an Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Tables, Alleys, Gallerys, or other devices Passed by the Common Council and Approved by the Mayor of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, on the 11th Day of April, 1932, passed by the Common Council on May 29, 1933, be amended by adding a subsection thereto to be numbered Section II (a) and to read as follows:

SECTION II: (a) That when the words pool or billiard table appear herein, the same shall include any and all types of pool or billiard tables, whether operated manually or mechanically.

SECTION III: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
