

SECTION 8: All dogs taken to the City Dog Pound shall be disposed of as follows:

(a) All licensed dogs will be identified and the owners notified. Such dogs will be held in said Pound for a period of seven (7) days to be claimed by the owner. In the event such owner claims such dog he shall pay fine set out in Section 10 hereof before said dog will be released.

(b) All unlicensed dogs will be considered stray. Such dog shall be held in said Pound for a period of three (3) days. In the event the owner of said dog claims him within said period he shall present proof of the purchase of a license therefor and in addition shall pay the fine set out in Section 10 hereof.

In addition to the charges set out above, the owner shall pay for the Board of said dog during the period it was held in said Pound.

SECTION 9: In the event any dog remains unclaimed at the end of the period set out in Section 8(a) or 8(b) above it shall be taken care of in a humane manner by the Operator of the Dog Pound.

SECTION 10: There is hereby established the following schedule of fines to be imposed on the owners of dogs claimed at the Dog Pound.

For the first offense \$5.00

For the second offense \$10.00

For all subsequent offenses \$25.00

Such fines shall be collected by the operator of the City Dog Pound and remitted at the close of each day to the Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon, Indiana. Such fines shall be deposited in the special fund set out in Section 3 above.

SECTION 11: Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance may be fined in any amount not exceeding \$100.00.

SECTION 12: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith and specified Ordinance No. 41, passed 27 of March, 1911 and No. 16, passed May 7, 1956 are hereby repealed.

SECTION 13: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty days after its passage and publication according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 74-5

ACCEPTANCE BY COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
LEBANON, INDIANA, OF PETITION FOR ANNEXATION
AND DEDICATION AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF TRACT
OF REAL ESTATE FOR SINGLE FAMILY DWELLINGS
USE TO THE CITY OF LEBANON, BOONE COUNTY,
INDIANA

The undersigned, Ann Garoffolo, Clerk-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, hereby certifies that at a regular meeting of the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana held in the Council chambers in the Municipal Building in said City of Lebanon, Indiana, on the 8th day of April, 1974, the following proceedings were had:

With the Honorable Robert M. Campbell, Mayor, presiding, the roll call showed all members of the Common Council present and voting.

Councilman James Acton made the following motion to adopt an ordinance which reads as follows, to-wit:

1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that the real estate as is hereinafter described, to-wit:
The southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section 25, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, containing 40 acres, Also, commencing at the Southwest corner of the Southeast quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 25, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, and run north 60 rods, more or less, to the center of Reynolds Ditch, thence east with the center of Reynolds Ditch to the west line of Cynthia A. Tyre's land, about 49 rods, thence south with the west line of said Tyre's land 57½ rods to the south line of said tract, thence west to the beginning, containing 16 acres, more or less, except therefrom the following described tract, to-wit:

1. Beginning at southwest corner of the aforesaid northwest quarter section, run thence east along and with the north line thereof 2083.13 feet to a point in the west right of way line of Penn-Central Railroad, formerly the Pennsylvania Railroad; thence northwardly along said west right of way line, deflecting left 90 degrees 27 minutes, a distance of 102.20 feet; thence continue along said right of way line and on a curve to the left, having a radius of 5679.58 feet, a distance of 207.93 feet measured on a chord of said curve, said chord deflecting from the last described line 1 degree 36 minutes; thence westwardly, parallel to the south line of the aforesaid quarter section a distance of 2078.75 feet to a point in the west line of the aforesaid quarter section; thence southwardly deflecting left 90 degrees 43 minutes along said west line 310.00 feet to the place of beginning, containing 14.816 acres, more or less, and leaving after said exception 41.184 acres more or less, and located in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana.
