RESOLUTION NO. 74-6

PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE
EXTENSION OF SANITARY SEWER

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that;

SECTION I: An extension of the sanitary sewer line which runs parallel to Ulen Drive North of its intersection with Outer Drive North in the City of Lebanon should be designed.

SECTION II. The route of said sewer line shall be as follows:

"Beginning at the northern most end of the existing 8 inch sewer east of Ulen Drive remove the existing lamphole and replace with a manhole, parallel to Ulen Drive and approximately 10 feet east of the back lot boundary, construct approximately 1010 feet of 8 inch sewer: proceeding northwest, parallel to Elizaville Road and approximately 10 feet northeast of the back lot boundary, construct approximately 1250 feet of 8 inch sewer."
