

RESOLUTION NO. 73-8  
 RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING  
 NO PARKING ON THE WEST  
 SIDE OF MERIDIAN STREET

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:  
 SECTION I: It is hereby established on the West side of Meridian Street from the North curb line of West Ash Street, North to the first alley intersecting Meridian Street from the West. Parking is prohibited in said No Parking Zone at any time.

SECTION II: Violators of this Resolution are subject to having their vehicles towed away and may be cited into City Court and fined an amount not to exceed \$25.00.

SECTION III: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

RESOLUTION NO. 73-9  
 RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO  
 THOMAS J. BURRIN FOR HIS YEARS  
 OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE  
 CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana, did in 1942, purchase the Lebanon Electric Utility from the Public Service Company of Indiana, and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana, did at that time organize a Utility Service Board which was charged with the duty of operating the City Utilities; the Electric Utility, the Water Utility, and the Sewage Treatment Utility, and

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board required the services of a person skilled in management, engineering, personnel, and public relations, to serve as superintendent of the City Utility Department, and

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Burrin did enter on said employment and has served continuously since that time until his retirement, effective November 1, 1973, and

WHEREAS, during said period, the Utility Service Department, under his skillful guidance, has constructed a completely new Sewage Treatment Plant with all the necessary interceptor sewers, Constructed a completely new Water Plant, updating all existing sub-standard water lines, and completely modernized the electric distribution systems, and

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Burrin, in his capacity as superintendent of the Utilities Department, has been primarily responsible for the progress of such department having executed complete skill in engineering, management, personnel, and public relations, and

WHEREAS, in addition to his service to the City, Thomas J. Burrin is a man who loves his community since its establishment and through his many civic activities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA;

SECTION I: That on behalf of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and its citizens, the dedicated skill and service of Thomas J. Burrin is hereby recognized.

SECTION II: That the City of Lebanon, Indiana, its officials and citizens do hereby extend their deepest gratitude and appreciation for many service Thomas J. Burrin has preformed for the community.

SECTION III: That this Resolution become a part of the official records of the City of Lebanon, Indiana; that copies be given to the Lebanon Reporter and Radio Station WNON for Publication; that an enrolled copy certified to by the Clerk-Treasurer be delivered to Thomas J. Burrin.
