RESOLUTION 74-18

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING  
 REGULATIONS FOR THE CONTROL  
 OF TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION  
 OF WEST MAIN STREET AND WEST STREET  
 AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA THAT:  
 SECTION 1.: All traffic, both street and pedestrian, approaching the intersection of West Main Street and West Street in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, during the period the automatic traffic control signal installed at such intersection is in operation shall observe the signal lights thereof as hereinafter set out.


SECTION 2: All traffic upon approaching said intersection during the period when the signal lights on such traffic control signal facing the direction from which such traffic is approaching are green shall have the right of way to and may enter said intersection for the purpose of turning or passing through. Should the signal light be red, such approaching traffic shall come to a complete stop and not enter said intersection until said signal light turns to green.

SECTION 3: In the event such automatic traffic control signal at such intersection fails to operate properly, then traffic on West Main Street shall have preferential right of way over that of West Street and traffic approaching such intersection on West Street shall come to a complete stop before proceeding into the intersection.

SECTION 4: Violation of the terms of this resolution shall be not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$25.00.

SECTION 5: This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
