

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #75-3

WHEREAS IT HAS BEEN DETERMINED THAT IT IS NOW NECESSARY TO APPROPRIATE MORE MONEY THAN WAS APPROPRIATED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET; NOW, THEREFORE:

SECTION I: Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana that for the expenses of said municipal corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

ORDINANCE #75-4

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
 A POLICE FIRING RANGE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1: There is hereby established a police firing range on land owned by the City bounded as follows:

On the east by the Penn Central Railroad, on the south by the Penn Central Railroad and on the north by Prairie Creek, being the site of the old sewage disposal plant.


SECTION 2: Trespassing on the above described real estate by other than police officers or those admitted thereon by the police department or other proper city officials.

SECTION 3: Said firing range shall be for the exclusive use of the Lebanon City Police Department. No person shall use said firing range unless under the direct supervision of a member of the Lebanon City Police Department.

SECTION 4: The use of said firing range shall be confined to the week days of Monday through Saturday. No shooting shall take place on said firing range on Sundays unless so designated as a special occasion by the proper City officials.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
