RESOLUTION NO. 75-8

RESOLUTION INDICATING THE BUILDING PERMIT  
SYSTEM WHICH THE COMMUNITY HAS ADOPTED AND  
THE REVIEW PROCEDURE FOR THE SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon has adopted and is enforcing a Zoning Code, and,

WHEREAS, Section 30-4 of Article II of the aforesaid prohibits any person, firm or corporation from erecting, constructing, enlarging, altering, repairing, improving, moving or demolishing any building or structure without first obtaining a separate building permit for each building or structure from the Building Inspector, and

WHEREAS, the Building Inspector must examine all plans and specifications for the proposed construction when application is made to him for a building permit.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

1. The Building Inspector shall review all building permit applications for new construction or substantial improvements to determine whether proposed building sites will be reasonably safe from flooding. If a proposed building site is in a location that has a flood hazard, any proposed new construction or substantial improvement (including prefabricated and mobile homes) must (i) be designed (or modified) and anchored to prevent flotation, collapse, or lateral movement of the structure, (ii) use construction materials and utility equipment that are resistant to flood damage, and (iii) use construction methods and practices that will minimize flood damage; and
2. The City Plan Commission shall review subdivision proposals and other proposed new developments to assure that (i) all public utilities and facilities, such as sewer, gas, electrical, and water systems are located, elevated, and constructed to minimize or eliminate flood damage, and (iii) adequate drainage is provided so as to reduce exposure to flood hazards; and
3. The Board of Health shall require new or replacement water supply systems and/or sanitary sewage systems to be designed to minimize or eliminate infiltration of flood waters into the systems and discharges from the systems into flood waters, and require on-site waste disposal systems to be located so as to avoid impairment of them or contamination from them during flooding.
4. The Building Inspector shall, if he determines any plans set out are in a location which has a flood hazard, refer the same to Natural Resources for review before any permits are issued therefor.
