

EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE #75-10

Whereas, certain extraordinary emergencies have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget, so that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; now, therefore, to meet such extraordinary emergencies:

SECTION 1: Be it ordained by the common Council of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana, that for the expenses of said Municipal Corporation the following additional sums of money are hereby appropriated and ordered set apart out of the several funds herein named and for the purposes herein specified, subject to the laws governing the same:

ORDINANCE NO. 75-11

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, THAT:

SECTION 1: The following described territory now contiguous to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, be and the same is hereby annexed to and declared to be a part of the City of Lebanon, Indiana:

A part of the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 29, Township 19 North, Range 1 East of the Second Principal Meridian and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on the west line of said tract 250 feet south of the northwest corner thereof, thence east parallel to the north line of said quarter quarter section 230 feet, thence south parallel to the west line of said quarter quarter section 110 feet, thence west parallel to the north line of said quarter quarter section 230 feet to a point in the west line thereof, thence north on said west line 110 feet to the place of beginning, containing 0.581 acres, more or less, but subject to legal highways, rights of way and easements.

SECTION 2: Said above described territory be and the same is now zoned as "S" Suburban Residential.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
