Technical Portions of the Rate Ordinance

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3-1970 ENTITLED AN  
ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF  
AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY  
CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

There shall be and there are hereby established for the use of and the services rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Lebanon, the following rates and charges, based upon the amount of water supplied during each monthly billing period:

<u>Consumption per Month</u>	<u>Rate per 100 Cubic Feet</u>
First 500 cubic feet	\$ 0.88
Next 1,000 cubic feet	.78
Next 2,000 cubic feet	.66
Next 4,000 cubic feet	.56
Next 8,000 cubic feet	.45
Over 15,000 cubic feet	.35

Each user shall pay a minum monthly charge in accordance with the size of meter installed for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out in the above schedule of rates.

<u>Minimum Charge Meter Size</u>	<u>Per Month</u>
5/8 - 3/4 inch meter	\$ 2.64
1 inch meter	5.25
1-1/4 inch meter	10.50
1-1/2 inch meter	14.00
2 inch meter	21.00
3 inch meter	42.00
4 inch meter	70.00
6 inch meter	140.00

Public Fire Protection

The amount to be paid by the City of Lebanon for fire hydrant rental shall be \$105.00 per hydrant per year, payable semi-annually.

Private Fire Protection

Hydrant Rental - each per annum \$105.00

Collection of Deferred Payment Charge

All Bills for water service not paid within 10 days from the due date thereof shall as stated in such bills, shall be subject to a collection of deferred payment charge of 10% on the first \$3.00 and 3% on the excess over \$3.00.

Temporary Users

Water supplies for railroad use may be charged for on such terms as shall be fixed by specific contract approved by the Common Council and the Public Service Commissioners of Indiana.

Technical Portions of the Rate Ordinance

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 46-1957, ENTITLED AN  
ORDINANCE FIXING THE SCHEDULE OF RATES AND CHARGES TO BE  
COLLECTED BY THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, FROM THE OWNERS  
OF PROPERTY SERVED BY THE SEWAGE WORKS OF SAID CITY AND  
OTHER MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 46-1957, passed and adopted July 15, 1957, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. For the use of and the service rendered by said sewage works, rates and charges shall be collected from the owners of each and every lot, parcel of real estate
