

cents (\$0.15) shall be made for each pound.

To determine the strength of the sewage and wastes samplings an analyses may be made from time to time by the City.

The determination of suspended solids and of five day biological oxygen demand contained in the wastes shall be in accordance with the latest copy of "Standard Methods of Water Analysis," as written by the American Public Health Association and the American Waterworks Association.

(h) For the service rendered to the City of Lebanon, said City shall be subject to the same rates and charges hereinabove provided, or to charges and rates established in harmony therewith.

(i) Such rates and charges shall be prepared and billed by the City of Lebanon, and shall be collected in the manner provided by law and ordinance.

(j) The rates and charges may be billed to the tenant or tenants occupying the properties served, unless otherwise requested in writing by the owners, but such billings shall in no wise relieve the owner from liability in the event payment is not made as herein required. The owners of the properties served, which are occupied by tenants, shall have the right to examine the collection records of the City for the purpose of determining whether such rates and charges have been paid by such tenants; provided that such examination shall be made at the office at which said records are kept and during the hours that such office is open for business.

Section II. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

JOINT RESOLUTION #75-1
JOINT RESOLUTION OF LEBANON COMMUNITY SCHOOL CORPORATION
AND CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, FOR TRANSFER OF
LEBANON JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL BUILDINGS

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of Lebanon Community School Corporation, Lebanon, Indiana, and the City of Lebanon, Indiana, Lebanon, Indiana, to transfer the Lebanon Junior High School Building complex located on North Meridian Street and North Lebanon Street in Lebanon, Indiana, from Lebanon Community School Corporation to City of Lebanon, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of each governmental body to take such actions and steps necessary to effectuate such transfer under the law; and

WHEREAS, specifically it is the intent of the Lebanon Community School Corporation to transfer said building complex to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, for and in consideration of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, transferring to the Lebanon Community School Corporation certain real estate owned by the City of Lebanon, Indiana, adjacent to and surrounding the Lebanon High School, Lebanon, Indiana, at or near Essex Street in Lebanon, Indiana, which is presently subject to a lease from the City of Lebanon, Indiana, to the Lebanon Community School Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED severally and collectively by Lebanon Community School Corporation and the City of Lebanon Indiana that the Junior High complex of buildings and land upon which they sit be transferred from the Lebanon Community School Corporation to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and in exchange therefor the City of Lebanon, Indiana, transfers to the Lebanon Community School Corporation the real estate adjacent to and surrounding the INSERT Lebanon High School owned by the City of Lebanon, Indiana, to Lebanon Community School Corporation and said City will transfer said property to Lebanon Community School Corporation in exchange for the transfer of the Junior High property, all pursuant to the laws of the State of Indiana, generally and specifically Burns Indiana Statutes Annotated, s28-1743 and I.C. _____ and that both governmental bodies take such steps as are necessary and prudent to accomplish such transfer pursuant to the law and further both governmental bodies agree to jointly file a petition with the Boone County Circuit Court seeking an appraisal provided for by law.
