

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Lebanon has received a Resolution of the Utility Service Board representing the need to increase rates and charges of the Municipal Electric Utility to provide additional revenues equal to the amount of increase in cost of wholesale electricity purchased from Public Service Indiana and the increase in gross income tax in order to continue the operation of the Municipal Electric Utility in a sound financial basis: 417

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA: Section 1. That the rates and charges for services rendered by the Municipal Electric Utility of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, be, and the same are, hereby ordered as follows:

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage; provided, however, that the schedule of rates and charges herein before set out shall not become effective unless approved by the Public Service Commission of Indiana, or until such time and manner as the Commission shall direct.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 18
OF THE CITY CODE OF LEBANON, INDIANA
TO DEFINE THE AUTHORITY OF THE BOARD OF PARK
COMMISSIONERS IN OPERATING THE DEPARTMENT OF
PUBLIC PARKS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA.
ORDINANCE 76-6

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA THAT:
SECTION 1: Article II of Chapter 18 of the City Code of Lebanon, Indiana, be amended by adding thereto the following sections:

SECTION 18-16: The Board of Park Commissioners shall have the responsibility for operation and maintenance of Lebanon Memorial Park, James A. Hill Memorial Park, the Seashore Swimming Pool and Abner H. Longley Park; that the budgets of said parks shall be transferred to the Department of Public Parks and such budgets shall become the budget of the Department of Public Parks of the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

SECTION 18-17: The Board of Park Commissioners shall have the responsibility for the operation of the recreational part of Memory Hall and shall be responsible for the maintenance of Memory Hall. The budget of Memory Hall shall be transferred to and become a part of the budget of the Department of Public Parks; provided, however, the leasing of space in Memory Hall shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works of the City of Lebanon, Indiana.

SECTION 18-18: All rules and regulations heretofore adopted by the City of Lebanon, Indiana, or any of its departments for the use of the Parks of Lebanon, Indiana, or Memory Hall shall remain in full force and effect, and are hereby made a part of this Ordinance by reference.

SECTION 18-19: Additions to the Public Parks of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Public Works and Safety.

SECTION 18-20: The Director of Parks and Recreation shall be appointed by the Mayor and Common Council from applicants interviewed and recommended by the Board of Park Commissioners.

SECTION 18-21: From and after the taking effect of this Ordinance, the present bodies having direction and control of the Parks within the City shall be and the same are hereby dissolved provided however, that they shall continue in existence until such time as their budgets have been transferred to the Department of Parks and Recreation and the Board of Park Commissioners set out in Section 18-15 of the Lebanon City Code have been formed and officially organized.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
