

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

SECTION 1: The speed limit on the streets in Prairie Heights subdivision shall be fifteen (15) miles per hour.

SECTION 2: Traffic on Sam Ralston Road is hereby declared to have the right-of-way over traffic on the following intersecting streets:

- Manor Drive
- Prairie Drive

Traffic on Manor Drive is hereby declared to have the right-of-way over Danielle Road.

Appropriate stop signs shall be installed at the intersections of the above streets.

SECTION 3: Traffic shall yield within said subdivision as set out below:

- Prarie Drive shall yeild to Manor Drive
- Lacy Court shall yield to Manor Drive
- Kelli Court shall yield to Danielle
- Manor Drive shall yeild to Danielle

Appropriate yeild signs shall be installed at the intersections of the above streets.

SECTION 4: Additional subdivisions and streets may be included within the provisions of this Resolution at such times as the Board of Works deems necessary. The penalty for the violation of the terms hereof shall be \$25.00.

SECTION 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Board of Public Works and Safety, approval by the Common Council and Mayor and publication according to law.
