ORDINANCE NO. 76-23
AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN
CONTIGUOUS TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that:

Section 1. The following described real estate, owned by Charles W. Wolfe and Mary A. Wolfe, now contiguous to the City of Lebanon, Indiana, be and the same is hereby annexed and declared to be a part of the City of Lebanon, Indiana:

A part of the southeast quarter of Section 30 and also a part of the north-east quarter of Section 31, both in Township 19 North, Range 1 East, situated in Center Township, Boone County, Indiana; and being more particularly described, as follows, to-wit:

Begin at a railroad rail at the southeast corner of the aforesaid Section 30 and proceed thence South 0°01'31" West, along the east line of the section, for a distance of 199.94 feet; thence North 89°45'05" West to the centerline of the Mann Drain, the same being a point in the boundary line of the City of Lebanon, Indiana; thence northeast with said centerline and boundaryline to the east line of the section; thence South 0°01'31" West, with said section line, for a distance of 225.03 feet to the point of beginning.

Section 2. The said above described real estate be, and the same is now zoned as "AA" residential.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication, according to law.

ORDINANCE NO. 76-24
ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION F AND SECTION H
OF ORDINANCE # 76-13, AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF
CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA, BEGINNING
JANUARY, 1977.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that:

Section 1. Section F of the Salary Ordinance shall be amended to read as follows: Salary of Desk Men from \$ 5510.95 annually to \$ 7643.91 annually or \$ 459.24 monthly to \$ 636.99 monthly.

Section 2. Section F of the Salary Ordinance shall read Salary of Third Class \$ 8574.47 for Patrolman, \$ 8574.47 for Replacement Officer, and \$ 8574.47 for Chief Dispatcher and Records Clerk.

Section 3. Section H. Salary of Building Inspector from \$ 4500.00 to \$ 9500.00 annually or from \$ 375.00 monthly to \$ 791.00 monthly.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage on the 27th day of December, 1976.

ORDINANCE NO. 76-25
ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 24-31
OF THE LEBANON CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana that:

Section 1. Section 24-31-2 of the Lebanon City Code shall be amended to read by adding thereto a new subsection "e" which will read as follows:

(Section 24-31-2) e. That in lieu of the above and foregoing bond, the developer may furnish certificates of performance bonds running to the developer and the City of Lebanon from his subcontractors who are chargeable with installing the improvements thereon, accumulative total of which bonds shall equal one hundred percent (100%) of the total estimated cost of all improvements and installations provided in the record plat.

Section 2. That there shall be added to Section 24-31-3 of the Lebanon City Code a new subsection which shall read as follows:

(Section 24-31-3) a. The developer may furnish in lieu of the above and foregoing maintenance bond, bonds from his subcontractors which comply with all of the requirements of the above and foregoing section.
