ORDINANCE NO. 78-20
 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ARTICLE III OF CHAPTER 25 OF THE CITY CODE OF LEBANON, INDIANA BY ADDING SEC. 25-36 TO ADOPT THE PURCHASED POWER COST ADJUSTMENT TRACKING CLAUSE OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION OF INDIANA ORDER OF DECEMBER 17, 1976 IN CAUSE NO. 34614

BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

SECTION 1: Section 25-36 be added to the City Code of Lebanon, Indiana which shall read as follows:

Section 25-36-Power Tracking Clause: The City of Lebanon, Indiana hereby adopts Appendix B of the Order entered by the Public Service Commission of Indiana on December 17, 1976 in Cause No. 34614 as its formula for passing the cost of purchased power thru to its customers; that a copy of said Appendix B is attached to this Ordinance as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
