ORDINANCE NO. 78-23

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SALARY ORDINANCE NO. 77-25 PASSED ON DECEMBER 12, 1977, WHICH AMENDED SALARY ORDINANCE NO. 77-14, PASSED ON JULY 25, 1977 AND ORDINANCE NO. 78-21 SALARY ORDINANCE FOR 1979 PASSED ON AUGUST 28, 1978. THE ORDINANCE FIXES THE SALARY OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES

Section 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, two-thirds of its members being present and concurring therein:

ORDINANCE NO. 78-24

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND SERVICES RENDERED BY THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, BOONE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Utility Service Board of the City of Lebanon has found that the existing rates and charges for the use of and service rendered by the waterworks of said City were too low and were insufficient to enable the City to properly operate its waterworks plant, provide for depreciation, make necessary improvements, and fund the debt service of the Waterworks Revenue Bonds of 1979; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council pursuant to consideration and investigation of the financial situation of the waterworks, has determined that an increase in the rates and charges of the utility is necessary, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, INDIANA:

Section 1. There shall be and there are hereby established for the use of and services rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Lebanon, the following rates and charges, based upon the amount of water supplied during each monthly billing period:

First	500 Cubic Feet	\$ 2.94
Next	1,000 Cubic Feet	2.62
Next	2,000 Cubic Feet	2.24
Next	4,000 Cubic Feet	1.90
Next	8,000 Cubic Feet	1.49
Over	15,500 Cubic Feet	1.17

Each user shall pay a minimum monthly charge in accordance with the size of meter installed for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out in the above schedule of rates.
