Public Fire Protection

The amount to be paid by the City of Lebanon for fire hydrant rental shall be \$336.00 per hydrant per year, payable semi-annually.

Private Fire Protection

Hydrant Rental - each per annum \$336.00

Tapping Fees

Each user, at the time he is connected with the waterworks system, shall pay a charge to cover the costs of tapping the main, furnishing and laying service pipe, corporation and stop cocks, service and meter box and installing the meter.

The charge for 5/8 inch meter tap shall be \$125.00. The charge for a 3/4 or 1 inch meter tap will be the costs of labor and materials and will be not less than \$150.00. The charge for a tap larger than 1 inch will be the cost of labor and materials.

Section 2: That all other provisions of Ordinance No. 78-24 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 79-2

AN ORDINANCE AS AMENDED ESTABLISHING A UNIFIED
DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ("UD") AND ESTABLISHING THE
ZONING AND USE IN SAID ("UD") DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, that:

SECTION 1: The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, Indiana, and the zoning maps, which are made a part thereof, be amended in the following particulars:

The following described real estate in the City of Lebanon, Indiana, is hereby zoned for Unit Development ("UD"), which zoned district under ("UD") classification shall permit the following uses:

(a) Single dwellings, two family dwellings and multi-family dwellings and garden apartment uses pursuant to Section 30.17 ("C Residence District"), but that mobile home parks as a conditional use shall be prohibited as to the two tracts marked MULTI-FAMILY DWELLINGS set forth in the middle section of the plot plan approved by the Lebanon City Plan Commission at a public hearing November 20, 1978.

(b) That all other lots, et cetera, shown on said plot plan be and the same is hereby zoned AAA Residential.

The real estate, which is the subject of this Zoning Ordinance, is described as follows, to wit:

A part of the Southeast quarter of Section 24, Township 19 North, Range 1 West, and a part of the Southwest quarter of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 1 East, of the Second Principal Meridian located in the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana. Beginning at the Northeast corner of the Southeast quarter of Section 24, Township 19 North, Range 1 West proceed North 89 degrees, 38 minutes, 29 seconds West with the section line (centerline of Road 250 North) for a distance of 1149.49 feet, thence South 0 degrees, 07 minutes, 34 seconds West for a distance of 1174.80 feet, thence South 89 degrees, 38 minutes, 29 seconds East for a distance of 53.88 feet, thence South 10 degrees, 21 minutes, 55 seconds East for a distance of 135.64 feet, thence South 10 degrees, 15 minutes, 32 seconds East for a distance of 671.11 feet, thence North 79 degrees, 44 minutes, 28 seconds East for a distance of 229.86 feet along and with the Northern line of Section One, Ulen North, thence South 10 degrees, 15 minutes, 32 seconds East for a distance of 60.00 feet, thence North 79 degrees, 44 minutes, 28 seconds East for a distance of 408.58 feet, thence South 89 degrees, 41 minutes, 54 seconds East for a distance of 311.89 feet to the line between Section 19 and Section 24, thence continue South 89 degrees, 41 minutes, 54 seconds East in
