day fixed in the bond sale notice, at which time and place she shall open and consider the bids. Bidders for said bonds shall be required to name the rate or rates of interest which the bonds are to bear, not exceeding the rate hereinbefore named. Such interest rate or rates shall be multiples of one-eighth (1/8) or one-tenth (1/10) of one per cent (1%), and not more than three (3) different interest rates shall be named by each bidder. The Clerk-Treasurer shall award the bonds to the highest qualified bidder. The highest bidder shall be the one who offers the lowest net interest cost to the City, to be determined by computing the total interest on all of the bonds to their maturities and deducting therefrom the premium bid, if any. No bid for less than the par value of said bonds, including accured interest to the date of delivery, shall be considered. The Clerk-Treasurer shall have full right to reject any and all bids. In the event no satisfactory bids for said bonds are received at the time fixed in said notice, the sale may be continued from day to day thereafter for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, without readvertisement, but during the continuation of such sale no bid shall be accepted which is lower than the highest bid received at the time fixed for said sale in the bond sale notice.

Prior to the delivery of said bonds, the Clerk-Treasurer shall be authorized to obtain a legal opinion as to the validity of said bonds from Ice Miller Donadio & Ryan, bond counsel of Indianapolis, Indiana, and to furnish such opinion to the purchaser of said bonds. The cost of said opinion shall be considered as a part of the cost of the projects on account of which said bonds are issued, and shall be paid out of the proceeds

of said bonds.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and isgning by the Mayor.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$550,000.00 TO BE APPLIED ON THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW SWIMMING POOL, PARKING LOTS IN MEMORIAL PARK, LIGHTS FOR MEMORIAL PARK BASEBALL DIAMOND, NEW CEILINGS AND NEW WINDOWS IN MEMORY HALL, AND RENOVATION OF THE HEATING SYSTEM IN MEMORY HALL: TOGETHER WITH THE INCIDENTAL EXPENSES IN CONNECTION THEREWITH AND ON ACCOUNT OF THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, the Board of Public Works and Safety has requested an appropriation in the amount of \$550,000.00 to be applied on the cost of construction of a new swimming pool, parking lots in Memorial Park, lights for Memorial Park baseball diamond, new ceilings and new windows in Mrmory Hall and renovation of the heating system in Memory Hall including the incidental expenses necessary to be incurred in connection with such projects and the issuance of bonds to procure the necessary funds therefore; and
