WHEREAS, as a result of the sale of revenue bonds produced an actual interest rate by which it was determined that Ordinance No. 79-1 should be amended to reduce the amount of the interest in rates from 200% to 186%; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, BOONE COUNTY, INDIANA:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 79-1, adopted on January 3, 1979, amending Ordinance No. 78-24 adopted on November 27, 1978, entitled "An Ordinance establishing rates and charges for the use of and services rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Lebanon, Boone County, Indiana," be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. 1. There shall be and there are hereby established for use of and services rendered by the waterworks system of the City of Lebanon, the following rates and charges, based upon the amount of water supplied during each monthly billing period.

First 500 Cubic Feet	\$ 2.66
Next 1,000 Cubic Feet	2.37
Next 2,000 Cubic Feet	2.03
Next 4,000 Cubic Feet	1.72
Next 8,000 Cubic Feet	1.34
Next 15,500 Cubic Feet	1.06

Each user shall pay a minimum monthly charge in accordance with the size of meter installed for which the user will be entitled to the quantity of water set out in the above schedule of rates.

Tapping Fees

Each user, at the time he is connected with the waterworks system, shall pay a charge to cover the costs of tapping the main, furnishing and laying service pipe, corporation and stop cocks, service and meter box and installing the meter.

The charge for 5/8 inch meter tap shall be \$125.00. The charge for a 3/4 of 1 inch meter tap will be the costs of labor and materials and will be not less than \$150.00. The charge for a tap larger than 1 inch will be the cost of labor and materials.

Section 2: That all other provisions of Ordinance No. 78-24 as amended by Ordinance No. 79-1 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and signing by the Mayor.

ORDINANCE NO. 79-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN INDUSTRIAL COST RECOVERY SYSTEM FROM INDUSTRIAL USERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON'S WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITIES

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon, Indiana has accepted a grant from the environmental protection agency in the amount of approximately \$1,988,028 under E.P.A. Project No. C180613-C for the construction of wastewater treatment facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 204 (b) (1) of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972 mandates that the Regional Administrator of Environmental Protection Agency Region V in Chicago, Illinois, require of the recipients of federal grants for treatment works awarded after March 1, 1973, that each grantee recover from industrial users of the treatment facilities that portion of the federal grant amount allocable to the treatment of wastes from such users; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lebanon is desirous of complying with the aforementioned regulations promulgated by the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency relative to
